For Division I and PSL

Before the final placement of qualifying players takes place, RE United Soccer Club must ensure that both players and parents are made fully aware of the various time and financial commitments required for PSL\Div.1 players. These include:

1) Player Commitment: PSL/Div.1 teams have an extended season, beginning _____, and finishing-up in _____. All players are expected to make themselves available to their teams during this time.

The Provincial Soccer League (PSL) is the highest level of soccer available in the province. Games will be played in a variety of cities across the province. (eg. Yorkton, Prince Albert, Saskatoon). Winners of this league can go on to play in the finals at the national level. The games are generally on weekends and extensive travel at the player's expense is involved.

The PSL/Div.1 programs are high level competitive leagues, aimed at both individual and team development. **ALL PSL/DIV.1 TEAMS MUST BE THE MAIN COMMITMENT OF THE PARTICIPANTS.**

2) Games and Practices: Each team will have up to _____ games/practices per week. These numbers may be increased for critical events. Attendance at games and practices is compulsory, unless leave is given by the coach. Coaches should be prepared to justify player participation, based on that players commitment to the team.

3) Physical fitness: Players are expected to build-up and maintain their physical condition, as well as work independently, to improve their skills between games and practices.
